

CAMPUS TRANSFORMATION:

■ C.2.: UNIVERSITY LIVING QUARTERS – FUNCTIONAL INTEGRALNESS

Description:

- To ensure all the Canary Islands Campuses have an integrally functional programme, paying particular attention to university residences as a consolidating factor for leaning communities to enjoy life to the full.

Objectives:

- To create learning communities where life can be enjoyed to the full.
- To set up links between the University and City in order to facilitate access to all the equipment and services necessary to crystallise global university-citizen communities.
- To reinforce the residential use of the campuses of their surrounding areas.
- Specific Objectives in the ULL:
 - o Central Campus and Anchieta:
 - To increase synergies with the current urban context (Special Plan C^ºH^º) and future plans (Geneto – General Development Plan)
 - Construction of the University Institute of Building (4,730m²), adjacent to the central area
 - To adapt and extend the housing on the Campus (C.M. Santa María)- University residence project in the Cuartel del Cristo (maximum built area: 20,000 m²)
 - o Guajara Campus:
 - To increase the synergies with the current urban context: (northern campus sector– General Development Plan)
 - To adapt residence (Parque de las Islas) – Project of a total of 48 bioclimatic houses (2,500 m², for students, lecturers and researchers)
 - o Ofra Campus:
 - To strengthen synergies with the current functional urban context (hospital sector of Ofra)
- Specific objectives in the ULPGC:
 - o Tafira Campus:
 - To increase the programme of use of internal facilities (residence, restaurants, leisure, recreation) – To reinforce synergies with the current functional urban context (Tafira Baja) – Adapt and extend the housing of the Campus (Residences, Flats, Bungalows)
 - Project of 150 houses
 - o Obelisk Campus:
 - To reinforce synergies with the current functional urban context
 - o San Cristóbal Campus:
 - To reinforce synergies with the current functional urban context (Zárate – Hospital sector Hospital Insular – Clínica San Roque – Hospital Materno-Infantil)
 - Project of 150 houses
 - o Montaña Cardones Campus
 - To reinforce the internal functional equipment – weigh up possible synergies with use of annexes (Agricultural School; to the north, the Island Council’s Experimental Agricultural Farm)
 - o Presidential Headquarters’ Area – City of Las Palmas:
 - Adapt the “Las Palmas” university Residence (León y Castillo street)
